

## Contact Lens Wearer Policy

A contact lens exam is required if you want to wear contacts. During this exam, our optometrist will examine your eyes to decide if contact lenses will work for your vision correction needs.

The exam includes specialized testing needed to evaluate your eyes, measure for lens sizing, and to help determine which brand of contacts are best for your eyes.

### Prescription Validity & Renewal

- Contact lens prescriptions are valid **for one year** from the date they are written.
- A **yearly exam** is required to renew your prescription, even if you are satisfied with your current lenses and do not wish to make changes.

### Follow-Up Visits

Follow-up visits related to your contact lenses within **30 days** of your exam are included in the exam charge.

### What to Bring

If you currently wear contact lenses, please bring your:

- Contact lens boxes or a copy of your current prescription

### Insurance Coverage

Please check your vision insurance carrier to see if contact lens exams are covered under your policy. A contact lens exam requires an additional charge beyond the standard routine eye exam.

**Medical insurances** do not pay for contact lens exams. Please contact our office for contact lens exam fees.

### Ordering Contact Lenses

Philadelphia Eye Associates offers a **secure online platform** for the ordering of most contact lenses. Once your prescription is finalized, our staff will send you a secure link to sign up and place orders.

### Accessing Contact Lens Prescription

You may also access your contact lens prescription through our secure patient portal. Please ask our staff to confirm your portal is active at the time of your visit.
